Activities, Material & Environment:

1. Encourage sitting on mat with toys to play with while mother is washing clothes nearby.

- Surround child with pillows so that child is safe
- Place toys on pillow in the front in order to bring arms forward
- Remind mother to talk with and encourage child
- Encourage child to push back up when sitting balance is lost

2. Encourage sitting on soft ground near the tree when elders are sitting in the morning.

- Place child between the legs of the aunt as she sits with her feet stretched out
- Face child outward to see and interact with the group of elders as they talk
- Teach aunt to position child so that there is no support, but child is safe
- Remind everyone to talk with and encourage child
- Encourage child to push back up when sitting balance is lost
